AFTERNOON AP EXAM

- ▶ Students should arrive at their afternoon AP Exam testing site no later than **11:30 a.m.**

- ▶ Several No. 2 pencils (with erasers)
- ▶ Pens with black or blue ink

 - ▶ Students cannot share calculators.
- ▶ A ruler or straightedge (Protractor is not allowed) for AP Physics only
- ▶ AP watch (without an alarm)
- ▶ A valid government-issued or school-issued photo ID if you do not attend Panther Creek High School

Students should NOT bring:

- ▶ Electronic Equipment (cell phone, smartphone, laptop, portable listening or recording devices etc.)
- ▶ Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, mechanical or colored pencils
- ▶ Rulers, straightedges and protractors (except for AP Physics)
- ▶ Reference Guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- ▶ Computers
- ▶ Watches that beep or have an alarm
- ▶ Food or Drink
- ▶ Ear Plugs
- ▶ Clothing with subject related information
- ▶ Scratch paper
- ▶ Calculators (allowed only for AP Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Statistics Exam; see AP Exam Calculator Policy for what types/models of calculators are permitted for each of these subjects)

Calculator Policy

2016-17 AP Exam Calculator Policy

▶ Biology

- ▶ A simple four-function calculator (with square root) only.

▶ Calculus AB/BC

- ▶ Graphing Calculator (must be a Collegeboard approved calculator)

▶ Physics

- ▶ Four-function calculators; most types of scientific (nongraphing) calculators, provided they don't have unapproved features or capabilities.

▶ Chemistry

- ▶ Four-function calculators may be used but not recommended. Most types of scientific (nongraphing) calculators may be used, provided that they don't have unapproved features or capabilities.

▶ Statistics

- ▶ Each student is expected to bring a graphing calculator with statistical capabilities. A student can bring a nongraphing scientific calculator instead, as long as it has the required computational capabilities. (See AP Exam Policy for more information)

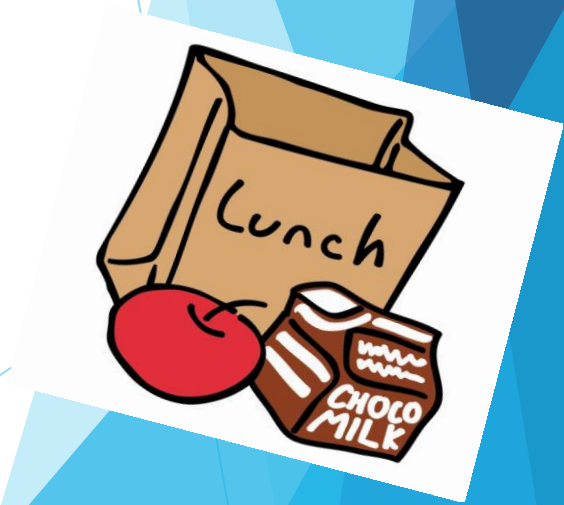
Lunch Procedures...

If you take a morning AP Exam Only (Except AP Human Geography)

- ▶ Students will be given instructions on what time to return to their afternoon classes before they are dismissed from each exam. Times will vary daily.
- ▶ Students will receive an hour for lunch.

 - ▶ 11th or 12th graders with approved off campus passes may use them.



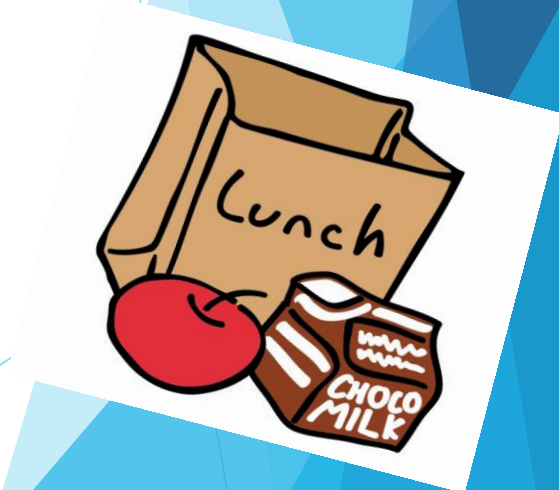
Lunch Procedures Con't...
