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Requesting Transcripts

In state colleges (not on Common App)

 Login to www.cfnc.org to request a transcript for *free*.

Out of state colleges (not on Common App)

 Request a transcript through <https://www.wcpss.net/transcripts>. The first three out-of-state and/or scholarship transcripts are free. There is a \$5 charge for each additional transcript.

Common Application/Coalition

 Link your caseload counselor in and they will upload our transcript to all schools on the Common App. Be sure to submit the correct contact information of your counselor.

****Helpful Tip:** You will receive an unofficial copy of your transcript. Save this and use it when appropriate in order to save on the number of transcripts that you need to request through WCPSS.

Students must request midyear reports in January if they are required by the college or university. Students are responsible for sending final reports.
